The large interior includes two eye wash stations, bench seating, mirrors, shelving and interior light. CALLAHEAD's EYE WASH STATION is completely self-contained, the only one of its kind in the world, and a first for the portable sanitation industry.



CALLAHEAD's EYE WASH STATION was especially created for chemical plants, construction and contracting jobs, laboratories, gas stations, welding shops, auto repair shops, emergency and firefighter locations or any location where airborne particles, chemicals, and hazardous materials are exposed. In accordance with OSHA, "Eyewash stations are critical emergency safety equipment to mitigate eye injuries when control methods do not prevent exposure to a physical or chemical irritant or a biological agent." The EYE WASH STATION is essential to provide immediate relief where chemical and hazardous materials are being handled. Having eye wash stations within 55-feet of any potential area of exposure will help eliminate serious eye damage when exposure occurs. The EYE WASH STATION is available for delivery throughout New York City's Five Boroughs, and all of Westchester, Nassau and Suffolk Counties.

CALLAHEAD's EYE WASH STATION is as impressive in its function as it is in its design. The exterior lime green color and white translucent roof complimented by the specially designed CALLAHEAD EYE WASH STATION signage will stand out.

The first 10 to 15 seconds are crucial after exposure to hazardous and corrosive substances. Chemical burns, corneal damage and blindness can occur without quick and effective treatment to prevent permanent damage and even vision loss. The EYE WASH STATION also protects workers from the elements, extreme temperatures, and inclement weather during their treatment.

The EYE WASH STATION's roomy interior boasts plenty of space for two eyewash stations. A wall mounted gravity-fed portable eyewash station has a tank pre-filled with PH balanced saline eye wash and does not require a plumbed water source. The flash flood emergency eye wash will deliver 3-minutes of hands-free flushing in both eyes simultaneously.

CALLAHEAD's EYE WASH STATION includes a 1-gallon cartridge of buffered PH balanced saline eye wash so there is no need for plumbing to operate. A second eye wash includes a double bottle wall mount containing two 16-ounce bottles of sterile ophthalmic solution. The ophthalmic solution helps clear the eyes of foreign material such as dust, pollen, and chemicals as well as provide relief to itchy or burning eyes. Sterile isotonic buffered solution is perfect for flushing or aerating the eyes or skin. Workers will feel comfortable and more secure during treatment inside the EYE WASH STATION's spacious interior with its faux leather bench seating, a shelving area for personal items, mirrors and interior lighting.

The EYE WASH STATION is constructed of high-density polyethylene for strength and the CALLAHEAD amazing design epitomizes the best in the industry. The self-closing lockable door triggers an occupancy sign for safety and privacy. The roomy interior design is equipped with high flow molded-in vent screens to eliminate any stagnant air and odors. EYE WASH STATIONS should be at every construction jobsite. Chemicals commonly used on construction sites include waterproofing agents, concrete mixtures, sealants, formaldehyde, grouts, adhesives, epoxy resins, solvent based paints, polymer bonding agents and so much more which can cause severe eye damage. According to the Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews, up to 22% of ocular trauma is caused by contact with chemicals.
